Beliefs: Covenants. Part-2

We believe according to the New Covenant and scripture, that we are <u>NOT</u> saved by our works or deeds of the law. (Matthew 5:20 & 23:2, John 1:17, Romans 3:20 & 7:6, Romans 10:4, Romans 8:3-4, Galatians 3:10, 5:4-5, Romans 9:31-33 --KJV)

As it is written;

* For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed *the righteousness* of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven. ^(Matthew 5:20 KJV)

* The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat: (Matthew 23:2 KJV)

* For the law was given by Moses, *but* grace and truth came by Jesus Christ. (John 1:17 KJV)

* Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law *is* the knowledge of sin. (Romans 3:20 KJV)

* But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of spirit, and not *in* the oldness of the letter. ^(Romans 7:6)

* For Christ *is* the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth. ^(Romans 10:4)

* For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: (Romans 8:3)

* That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. ^(Romans 8:4)

* For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed *is* every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them. ^(Galatians 3:10)

* Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from grace. ^(Galatians 5:4)

* For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith. (Galatians 5:5)

* But Israel, which followed after the law of righteousness, hath not attained to the law of righteousness. (Romans 9:31 KJV)

* Wherefore? Because *they sought it* not by faith, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumblingstone; (Romans 9:32 KJV)

* As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. (Romans 9:33 KJV)
