We believe according to scripture that the righteousness of the Messiah--Christ Himself is given/imputed unto us by faith! (Romans 4:5-7, Psalm 32:2, Romans 5:19,1, Romans 3:25-26, James 2:23, Romans 4:23-25, 13 --KJV)

As it is written:

- * But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness. (Romans 4:5)
- * Even as David also describeth the blessedness of the man, unto whom God imputeth righteousness without works, (Romans 4:6)
 - * Saying, Blessed are they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered. (Romans 4:7)
- * Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile. (Psalm 32:2 KJV)
- * For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous. (Romans 5:19 KJV)
- * Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: (Romans 5:1)
- * Whom God hath set forth *to be* a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; (Romans 3:25)
- * To declare, *I say*, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus. (Romans 3:26)
- * And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God. (James 2:23)
 - * Now it was not written for his sake alone, that it was imputed to him; (Romans 4:23)
- * But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead; (Romans 4:24)
 - * Who was delivered for our offences, and was raised again for our justification. (Romans 4:25)
- * For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, *was* not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith. (Romans 4:13)
