\* In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him.  $(1J_0 4:9 \text{ KJV})$ 

\* Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. <sup>(1]0 4:10 KJV)</sup>

\* Gracious is the LORD, and righteous; yea, our God is merciful. (Psa 116:5 KJV)

\*\* Therefore you are called to ... follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness. <sup>(1TI 6:11 KJV)</sup>

\* For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous. <sup>(1Jo 5:3 KJV)</sup>

### Our Lord and Saviour Christ said;

\* ... I know that his commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto me, so I speak. (Joh 12:50 KJV)

\* He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day. <sup>(Joh 12:48 KJV)</sup>

\* For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son: (Joh 5:22 KJV)

\* For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak. <sup>(Joh 12:49 KJV)</sup>

 $\ast\,$  On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.  $^{\rm (Mat~22:40~KJV)}$  and

\* This is the first and great commandment. <sup>(Mat 22:38 KJV)</sup>

\* ... Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. (Mat 22:37 KJV)

\* And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. (Mat 22:39 KJV)

\* If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen? <sup>(1Jo 4:20 KJV)</sup>

\* ... therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding. (Pro 4:7 KJV)

#### As Apostle Paul stated;

\* ... though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing. <sup>(1Co</sup> 13:2 KJV)

\* And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing.  $(1C_0 13:3 \text{ KJV})$ 

#### Simply put,

\* He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him. (Joh 14:21 KJV)
\* For whosoever shall do the will of my Father which is in heaven, the same is my brother, and sister, and mother. (Mat 12:50 KJV)

#### As Apostle John stated:

\* He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. <sup>(1Jo 2:4 KJV)</sup>
