

Precept Study: Virtuous!

Prepared on: May 18th, 2014

In regards to: The Characteristics, Qualities and Role of a Woman Pursuing Virtuousness. This precept study was inspired by a song titled **Virtuous by** my brother and brother in the faith, Brandin Daye (a.k.a **Poloh CO**).

Biblical precepts are in contrast to **the lyrics** of the song:

I'm all she want: ^{KJV} **Genesis 3:16** Unto the woman he said, thy desire *shall be* to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee.

She gone listen and do no trippin: ^{KJA} **Sirach 26:14** A silent and loving woman is a gift of the Lord; and there is nothing so much worth as a mind well instructed. ^{KJV} **Proverbs 9:13** A foolish woman *is* *clamorous: *she is* simple, and knoweth nothing. // **Clamorous:** loudly demanding, noisy complainer, to make loud outcries in distress.

She submitted, what I want she go get it (helper): ^{KJV} **Ephesians 5:22** Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. ^{KJV} **Genesis 2:18** And the LORD God said, *It is* not good that the man should be alone; *I will make him an* *help meet for him. ^{KJV} **Proverbs 31:17** She girdeth her loins with strength, and strengtheneth her arms. // **Help meet:** one who helps; one who brings relief through assisting.

I trust her, in my heart she got it: ^{KJV} **Proverbs 31:11** The heart of her husband doth safely trust in her, so that he shall have *no need of spoil. ^{KJA} **Sirach 26:2** A virtuous woman *rejoiceth her husband, and he shall fulfil the years of his life in peace. // **No need of spoil:** means, no lack of gain (Therefore her husband will not lack gain, he will prosper). | **Rejoiceth:** to make glad.

She worth more than rubies: ^{KJV} **Proverbs 31:10** Who can find a virtuous woman? for her price *is* far above rubies.

We gone live like we suppose: ^{KJV} **Ephesians 5:21** *Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God. ^{KJV} **Ephesians 5:23-24** For the husband is the *head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the Saviour of the body. Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so *let* the wives *be* to their own husbands in every thing. // **Submit:** to subject yourself to the authority of another; to serve your authority in compliance. | **Head:** ruler, leader, or chief.

We gone give thanks to the Lord: ^{KJV} **Ephesians 5:20** Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;

If I got it, she got it: ^{KJV} **Ephesians 5:25** Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; ^{KJV} **Ephesians 5:33** Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife *see* that she *reverence *her* husband. ^{KJV} **1 Corinthians 7:3** Let the husband render unto the wife due *benevolence: and likewise also the wife unto the husband. // **Reverence:** to regard with the deepest respect; to bow in awe and admiration; to submit in courtesy. | **Benevolence:** loving kindness; to do that which is good, kind.

Precept Study: Virtuous!

Both of us, it ain't no stoppin: ^{KJV} **Matthew 19:6** Wherefore they are no more *twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put *asunder. ^{KJA} **Sirach 26:22** a married woman is a *tower against death to her husband. ^{KJA} **Sirach 26:1** Blessed is the man that hath a virtuous wife, for the number of his days shall be double. // Twain: two | Asunder: separate or divide. | Tower: strong defense;

She subject to her man: ^{KJV} **Colossians 3:18** Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as it is fit in the Lord.

^{KJV} **1 Peter 3:5** For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, *adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands: // Adorn: set in order and gain honor.

According to scripture I'm her husband: ^{KJV} **Ephesians 5:31** For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh. ^{KJA} **Sirach 26:20** When thou hast gotten a fruitful possession through all the field, sow it with thine own seed, trusting in the goodness of thy stock. ^{KJV} **Proverbs 18:22** *Whoso* findeth a wife findeth a good *thing*, and obtaineth favour of the LORD.

She show me nothing but love: ^{KJV} **Proverbs 31:12** She will do him good and not evil all the days of her life. ^{KJA} **Sirach 36:23** If there be kindness, meekness, and comfort, in her tongue, then is not her husband like other men. ^{KJV} **Proverbs 31:23** Her husband is known in the gates, when he sitteth among the elders of the land.

She ain't greedy, she'll give to the needy: ^{KJV} **Proverbs 31:20** She stretcheth out her hand to the poor; yea, she reacheth forth her hands to the needy.

She's right there when I need her: ^{KJA} **Sirach 26:13** The grace of a wife delighteth her husband, and her *discretion will fatten his bones. // Discretion: the ability to make thoughtful decisions; the power to make good judgments through wise discernment.

She does me good, no evil: ^{KJA} **Sirach 26:3** A good wife is a good portion, which shall be given in the portion of them that fear the Lord. ^{KJA} **Sirach 26:26** A woman that *honoureth her husband shall be judged wise of all; but she that *dishonoureth him in her pride shall be counted ungodly of all. ^{KJV} **Proverbs 12:4** **she that maketh ashamed is as rottenness in his bones.**
// Honor: to glorify; to magnify or make greater. | Dishonor: to bring shame or disgrace upon;

When she speak it's so kind: ^{KJV} **Proverbs 31:26** She openeth her mouth with wisdom; and in her tongue is the law of kindness.

She'll wake up in the middle of the night: ^{KJV} **Proverbs 31:15** She riseth also while it is yet night, and giveth *meat to her household, and a portion to her maidens. // Meat: food, fruit, meat (animal), vegetation

She's all mine: ^{KJA} **Sirach 36:24** He that getteth a wife beginneth a possession, a help like unto himself, and a pillar of rest. ^{KJV} **1 Corinthians 7:4** The wife hath not power of her own body, but the husband: and likewise also the husband hath not power of his own body, but the wife.

Precept Study: Virtuous!

She virtuous, so hard to find: ^{KJV} Proverbs 31:10 Who can find a virtuous woman? for her price *is* far above rubies.

She treats me more than good, and gives respect: ^{KJV} 1 Timothy 3:11 Even so *must their wives be* *grave, not slanderers, sober, faithful in all things. ^{KJA} Sirach 26:24 A dishonest woman *contemneth shame: but an honest woman will *reverence her husband. // **Grave:** watchful and alert; quiet and composed; | **Contemneth:** to refuse to accept; will not bear or receive; to reject. | **Reverence:** to regard with the upmost respect in humility; to respectably submit in courtesy.

She bring something to the table, even if I wasn't able: ^{KJV} Proverbs 31:27 She looketh well to the ways of her household, and eateth not the bread of *idleness. // **Idleness:** laziness, slothfulness, sluggishness.

She's my crown, and is stable: ^{KJV} Proverbs 12:4 A virtuous woman *is* a crown to her husband: ^{KJV} Proverbs 31:18 She perceiveth that her merchandise *is* good: her candle goeth not out by night.

Head of the house, the Saviour: ^{KJV} 1 Corinthians 11:3 But I would have you know, that the *head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman *is* the man; and the head of Christ *is* God. // **Head:** ruler, leader, or chief.

I don't want no brawling woman: ^{KJV} Proverbs 25:24 *It is* better to dwell in the corner of the housetop, than with a *brawling woman and in a wide house. ^{KJV} Proverbs 27:15 A continual dropping in a very rainy day and a *contentious woman are alike. ^{KJV} Proverbs 21:19 *It is* better to dwell in the wilderness, than with a contentious and an angry woman. // **Brawling:** contentious. | **Contentious:** argumentative; to contend with in anger; to argue against in discord; to dispute; to oppose, refuse or reject stubbornly.

To other woman you can't compare: ^{KJA} Sirach 26:15 A *shamefaced and faithful woman is a double grace, and her *continent mind cannot be valued. // **Shamefaced:** being consciously aware of that which is a disgrace and dishonorable, and to refrain from doing such, in modesty. | **Continent:** sober, ability to restrain one's self; to be modest; to do in moderation; | **Modest:** to be humble and conduct yourself in the fear of God, to reverence God in uprightness.

She's not standard: ^{KJV} Proverbs 31:29 Many daughters have done virtuously, but thou excellest them all. ^{KJV} Proverbs 31:25 Strength and honour *are* her clothing; and she shall rejoice in time to come.

KJV = King James Version Bible | KJA = King James Version Apocrypha | Sirach is also known as Ecclesiasticus

This study was put together to inspire those eager to know some of the qualities and indicators **to identify a virtuous woman**. The core of it all is true love, being pure and genuine in the faith of Christ and yielding to the Word of God. Blessed is he who findeth a virtuous wife, for her price is far above rubies.
