This *Precept Study* started out as a warning to those scattering the sheep of God's pasture, advising these leaders to **REPENT**, **REPENT**! and come together in the faith of the Messiah Christ -- unto Sound Doctrine, **or be Judged!** To the flock, **trust in the Most High** GOD in Christ and **NOT in men!** 

#### As it is written;

- \* What? know ye not ... (1Co 6:16 KJV)
- \* ... there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction. (2Pe 2:1 KJV)
- \* And many shall follow their pernicious ways; by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of. (2Pe 2:2 KJV)
- \* And through covetousness shall they with feigned words make merchandise of you: whose judgment now of a long time lingereth not, and their damnation slumbereth not. (2Pe 2:3 KJV)
- \* ... go ye not therefore after them. (Luk 21:8 KJV)
- \* For I have not sent them, saith the LORD, yet they prophesy a lie in my name; that I might drive you out, and that ye might perish, ye, and the prophets that prophesy unto you. (Jer 27:15 KJV)



## Precept Study: STOP IDOLIZING PASTORS & Elders of the Church, False Leaders of the <u>BLIND</u> Woe Unto You!

- \* But my people would not hearken to my voice; ... (Psa 81:11 KJV)
- \* So I gave them up unto their own hearts' lust: and they walked in their own counsels. (Psa 81:12 KJV)
- \* For it is written, that ... (Gal 4:22 KJV)
- \* ... the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; (2Ti 4:3 KJV)
- \* Wherefore the Lord said, Forasmuch as this people draw near *me* with their mouth, and with their lips do honour me, but have removed their heart far from me, and their fear toward me is taught by the precept of men: (Isa 29:13 KJV)
- \* Thus saith the LORD; Cursed *be* the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from the LORD. (Jer 17:5 KJV)
- \* ... verily every man at his best state is altogether vanity. ... (Psa 39:5 KJV)
- \* .... he that is an hireling, and not the shepherd, .... seeth the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth: ... (Joh 10:12 KJV)
- \* Woe to the idol shepherd that leaveth the flock! the sword *shall be* upon his arm, and upon his right eye: his arm shall be clean dried up, and his right eye shall be utterly darkened. (Zec 11:17 KJV)
- \* Let them alone: they be blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into the ditch. (Mat 15:14 KJV)
- \* ... the Lord said, Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom *his* lord shall make ruler over his household, to give *them their* portion of meat in due season? (Luk 12:42 KJV)
- \* Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing. (Luk 12:43 KJV)
- \* Of a truth I say unto you, that he will make him ruler over all that he hath. (Luk 12:44 KJV)
- \* But and if that servant say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming; and shall begin to beat the menservants and maidens, and to eat and drink, and to be drunken; (Luk 12:45 KJV)



# Precept Study: STOP IDOLIZING PASTORS & Elders of the Church, False Leaders of the <u>BLIND</u> Woe Unto You!

- \* The lord of that servant will come in a day when he looketh not for *him*, and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in sunder, and will appoint him his portion with the unbelievers. (Luk 12:46 KJV)
- \* For there is no respect of persons with God. (Rom 2:11 KJV)
- \* Woe be unto the pastors that destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture! saith the LORD. (Jer 23:1 KJV)
- \* Therefore thus saith the LORD God of Israel against the pastors that feed my people; Ye have scattered my flock, and driven them away, and have not visited them: behold, I will visit upon you the evil of your doings, saith the LORD. (Jer 23:2 KJV)
- \* And I will gather the remnant of my flock out of all countries whither I have driven them, and will bring them again to their folds; and they shall be fruitful and increase. (Jer 23:3 KJV)
- \* And I will set up shepherds over them which shall feed them: and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, neither shall they be lacking, saith the LORD. (Jer 23:4 KJV)
- \* ... my people shall be satisfied with my goodness ... (Jer 31:14 KJV)
- \* And they shall say, ... (Eze 36:35 KJV)
- \* The LORD is my shepherd; I shall ... (Psa 23:1 KJV)
- \* .... lack nothing (Psa 23:1 NIV)
- \* Therefore ... (Heb 2:1 KJV)
- \* Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom. (Luk 12:32 KJV)
- \* Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. (Pro 3:5 KJV)
- \* It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in man. (Psa 118:8 KJV)
- \* ... for God, his way is perfect: the word of the LORD is tried ... (Psa 18:30 KJV)
  - \* O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him. (Psa 34:8 KJV)
