In Regards to apostle Paul's credibility as a God ordained apostle and preacher of the Gospel. A wave of deception has swept through various churches and "Israelite" camps teaching members that apostle Paul's letters are irrelevant and/or that they do not apply to their congregation or assembly. His letters are just as inspired as any other New Testament writings, making up the bulk of the New Testament.

This precept study proves by scripture, that Apostle Paul was ordained by God even with key disciples of Christ acknowledging and supporting his ministry. I've found that those who have a tendency to teach against apostle Paul, or have an issue with statements that he made, are usually those who do not understand his letters and have a problem with the fact that we are **Not** saved by our works of the law – but by grace. Those who hold to beliefs contrary to what Paul preached [mainly works based Salvation], can be considered "they of the circumcision" in today's time.

They would be the individuals attempting to stop Paul from preaching the true Gospel [Christ crucified]. Namely those who would come behind Paul and teach "another gospel" to those he preached to prior. **These are persecutors of the Way!** They have an issue with apostle Paul's teachings because **he fully exposed them in his writings** and **they seek to suppress his messages**, even in today's time.

As it is written;

- * ... Jesus said, Forbid him not: for there is no man which shall do a miracle in my name, that can lightly speak evil of me. (Mar 9:39 KJV)
- * ... God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul: (Act 19:11 KJV)
- * So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them. (Act 19:12 KJV)
- * ... our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you; (2Pe 3:15 KJV)
- * Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is, that they might be saved. (Rom 10:1 KJV)
- * For I bear them record that they have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge. (Rom 10:2 KJV)
- * For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and going about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God. (Rom 10:3 KJV)



- * ... it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called *me* by his grace, (Gal 1:15 KJV)
- * To reveal his Son in me, that I might preach him among the heathen; immediately I conferred not with flesh and blood: (Gal 1:16 KJV)
- * Neither went I up to Jerusalem to them which were apostles before me; but ... (Gal 1:17 KJV)
- * ... when James, Cephas, and John, who seemed to be pillars, perceived the grace that was given unto me, they gave to me and Barnabas the right hands of fellowship; that we *should go* unto the heathen, and they unto the circumcision. (Gal 2:9 KJV)
- * ... I speak to you Gentiles, inasmuch as I am the apostle of the Gentiles, I magnify mine office: (Rom 11:13 KJV)
- * If by any means I may provoke to emulation *them which are* my flesh, and might save some of them. (Rom 11:14 KJV)
- * ... I am made all things to all *men*, that I might by all means save some. (1Co 9:22 KJV)
- * According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another buildeth thereon. But let every man take heed how he buildeth thereupon. (ICo 3:10 KJV)
- * For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ. (1Co 3:11 KJV)
- * ... Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone; (Eph 2:20 KJV)
- * ... The stone which the builders refused ... (Psa 118:22 KJV)
- * As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. (Rom 9:33 KJV)
- * Remember that Jesus Christ of the seed of David was raised from the dead according to my gospel: (2Ti 2:8 KJV)
- * ... ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. (1Co 15:2 KJV)
- * ... I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry; (ITi 1:12 KJV)
- * For I am the least of the apostles, that am not meet to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. (ICo 15:9 KJV)



* But by the grace of God I am what I am: and his grace which *was bestowed* upon me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me. (ICo 15:10 KJV)

- * Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God... (2Co 1:1 KJV)
- * ... Grace *be* with you. Amen. (Col 4:18 KJV)
