A Special Message: A message and reminder to the Body of Christ, to bear YOUR cross and Follow the Lord! We often get caught up in what others are doing (or not doing) while in fact, we should be focusing on the ministry that we have received in the Lord—that we may fulfill it.

We must be about our Father's Business; Therefore, we must Mind Our Own! Luke 2:49

As it is written;

- * Then saith Jesus unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: ... (Mat 26:31 KJV)
- * Simon Barjona: ... (Mat 16:17 KJV)
- *.... Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: (Luk 22:31 KJV)
- * But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren. (Luk 22:32 KJV)
- * Peter answered and said unto him, Though all *men* shall be offended because of thee, *yet* will I never be offended. (Mat 26:33 KJV)
- * Peter said unto him, Though I should die with thee, yet will I not deny thee. (Mat 26:35 KJV)
- *.... Lord, I am ready to go with thee, both into prison, and to death. (Luk 22:33 KJV)
- * And he said, I tell thee, Peter (Luk 22:34 KJV)
- * ... That this day, even in this night, before the cock crow twice, thou shalt deny me thrice. (Mar 14:30 KJV)
- * .. three times. (Mar 14:30 NKJ)
- * But he spake the more vehemently, If I should die with thee, I will not deny thee in any wise. (Mar 14:31 KJV)
- * And when the hour was come ... (Luk 22:14 KJV)
- * ... Judas ... betrayed him ... (Joh 18:5 KJV)
- * ... to be crucified. (Mat 26:2 KJV)
- * And they that had laid hold on Jesus led *him* away to Caiaphas the high priest, where the scribes and the elders were assembled. (Mat 26:57 KJV)



- * And Simon Peter followed Jesus, and *so did* another disciple: that disciple was known unto the high priest, and went in with Jesus into the palace of the high priest. (Joh 18:15 KJV)
- * But Peter followed him afar off ... and (Mat 26:58 KJV)
- *.... stood at the door without. Then went out that other disciple, which was known unto the high priest, and spake unto her that kept the door, and brought in Peter. (Joh 18:16 KJV)
- * Then saith the damsel that kept the door unto Peter, Art not thou also *one* of this man's disciples? He saith, I am not. (Joh 18:17 KJV)
- * And Simon Peter stood and warmed himself. They said therefore unto him, Art not thou also *one* of his disciples? He denied *it*, and said, I am not. (Joh 18:25 KJV)
- * I do not know what you are talking about." (Mat 26:70 NRS)
- * And when he was gone out into the porch, another *maid* saw him, and said unto them that were there, This *fellow* was also with Jesus of Nazareth. (Mat 26:71 KJV)
- * And again he denied with an oath ... (Mat 26:72 KJV)
- *.... he began to curse and to swear, saying, I know not this man of whom ye speak. (Mar 14:71 KJV)
- * "I do not know this man you are talking about." (Mar 14:71 NRS)
- *.... and immediately the cock crew. (Joh 18:27 KJV)
- * And Peter remembered the word of the Lord, how he had said unto him, Before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice. (Luk 22:61 KJV)
- * ... three times. (Mar 14:30 NKJ)
- * And Peter went out, and wept bitterly. (Luk 22:62 KJV)
- * Then ... they took Jesus, and led him away. (Joh 19:16 KJV)
- * And he bearing his cross went forth into a place called *the place* of a skull, which is called in the Hebrew Golgotha: (Joh 19:17 KJV)
- * Where they crucified him, (Joh 19:18 KJV)
- * And ... he was buried, and ... rose again the third day according to the scriptures: (1Co 15:4 KJV)



- * After these things Jesus shewed himself again to the disciples at the sea of Tiberias; (Joh 21:1 KJV)
- * There were together Simon Peter, and Thomas called Didymus, and Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, and the *sons* of Zebedee, and two other of his disciples. (Joh 21:2 KJV)
- * Simon Peter saith unto them, I go a fishing. They say unto him, We also go with thee. They went forth, and entered into a ship immediately; and that night they caught nothing. (Joh 21:3 KJV)
- * ... Jesus stood on the shore: but the disciples knew not that it was Jesus. (Joh 21:4 KJV)
- * Then Jesus saith unto them, Children, have ye any meat? They answered him, No.
- * And he said unto them, Cast the net on the right side of the ship, and ye shall find. They cast therefore, and now they were not able to draw it for the multitude of fishes. (Joh 21:6 KJV)
- * Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved saith unto Peter, It is the Lord. Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he girt *his* fisher's coat *unto him*, ... and did cast himself into the sea. (Joh 21:7 KJV)
- * Jesus saith unto them, Bring of the fish which ye have now caught. (Joh 21:10 KJV)
- * ... Come and dine. (Joh 21:12 KJV)
- * This is now the third time that Jesus shewed himself to his disciples, after that he was risen from the dead. (Joh 21:14 KJV)
- * So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, Simon, *son* of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my lambs. (Joh 21:15 KJV)
- * He saith to him again the second time, Simon, *son* of Jonas, lovest thou me? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my sheep. (Joh 21:16 KJV)
- * He saith unto him the third time, Simon, *son* of Jonas, lovest thou me? Peter was grieved because he said unto him the third time, Lovest thou me? And he said unto him, Lord, thou knowest all things; thou knowest that I love thee. Jesus saith unto him, Feed my sheep. (Joh 21:17 KJV)
- * Verily, verily, I say unto thee, When thou wast young, thou girdedst thyself, and walkedst whither thou wouldest: but when thou shalt be old, thou shalt stretch forth thy hands, and another shall gird thee, and carry *thee* whither thou wouldest not. (Joh 21:18 KJV)



- * This spake he, signifying by what death he should glorify God. And when he had spoken this, he saith unto him, Follow me. (Joh 21:19 KJV)
- * For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: but whosoever will lose his life for my sake, the same shall save it. (Luk 9:24 KIV)
- * ... whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven. (Mat 10:33 KJV)
- * Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven (Mat 10:32 KJV)
- * ... and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. (Rom 10:10 KJV)
- * ... blessed is *he*, whosoever shall not be offended in me. (Luk 7:23 KJV)
- * He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. (Mat 10:37 KJV)
- * And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me. (Mat 10:38 KJV)
- * Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword. (Mat 10:34 KJV)
- * For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law. (Mat 10:35 KJV)
- *... Yea ... (Luk 11:28 KJV)
- *... the Son of man is betrayed! (Mar 14:21 KJV)
- *... so shall ye ... (Joh 15:8 KJV)
- *... be hated ... for my name's sake. (Mat 24:9 KJV)
- * Therefore... (Joh 21:7 KJV)
- * If any *man* come to me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple. (Luk 14:26 KJV)
- *... If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me. (Luk 9:23 KJV)
- * Fear not; ... (Rev 1:17 KJV)
- * Precious in the sight of the LORD is the death of his saints. (Psa 116:15 KJV)
- * Then Peter, turning about, seeth the disciple whom Jesus loved following; which also leaned on his breast at supper, and said, Lord, which is he that betrayeth thee? (Joh 21:20 KJV)



- * Peter seeing him saith to Jesus, Lord, and what shall this man do? (Joh 21:21 KJV)
- * Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee? (Joh 21:22 KJV)
- * ... You follow Me. (Joh 21:22 NKJ)
- * Take heed to the ministry which thou hast received in the Lord, that thou fulfil it. (Col 4:17 KJV)
