# Precept Study: Israel, the Dwelling Place of GOD – His Sanctuary.

**In Regards to:** Where the sanctuary of God is? Where does the Most High God dwell? Where is His Temple? What is Church?

According to **H4720** in the Strong's Concordance, the Hebrew word for **sanctuary** means; a sacred place, a holy place, or of the temple. In the Greek according to **G39**, sanctuary means; places sacred to God, set apart for God, holy.

#### As it is written;

- \* Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them; it shall be an everlasting covenant with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and will set my sanctuary in the midst of them for evermore. (Eze 37:26 KJV)
- \* Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and *that* the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? (1Co 3:16 KJV)
- \* If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which *temple* ye are. (1Co 3:17 KJV)
- \*... know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost *which is* in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? (1Co 6:19 KJV)
- \*... the most High dwelleth not in temples made with hands; as saith the prophet, (Act 7:48 KJV)
- \* Heaven *is* my throne, and earth *is* my footstool: what house will ye build me? saith the Lord: or what is the place of my rest? (Act 7:49 KJV)
- \* Jesus answered ...., If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode (our home NKJV) with him. (Joh 14:23 KJV)
- \* .... I will not leave you comfortless: .... (Joh 14:18 KJV)
- \* .... "I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you. (Joh 14:18 NKJ)
- \* .... God dealeth with you as with sons; ... (Heb 12:7 KJV)
- \* .... ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. (Joh 14:17 KJV)
- \* .... he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; (Joh 14:16 KJV)
- \* ... the servant abideth not in the house for ever: but the Son abideth ever. (Joh 8:35 KJV)
- \* ... he who was of the bondwoman was born after the flesh; but he of the freewoman was by promise. (Gal 4:23 KJV)

- \* Which things are an allegory: (Gal 4:24 KJV) .. symbolic. For these are the two covenants: (Gal 4:24 NKJ)
- \*.... this *shall be* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people. (Jer 31:33 KJV)
- \*.... for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD: .... (Jer 31:34 KJV)

#### (and)

- \* ... when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, (Gal 4:4 KJV)
- \* To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons. (Gal 4:5 KJV)
- \* So then, brethren, we are not children of the bondwoman, but of the free. (Gal 4:31 KJV)
- \* And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!" (Gal 4:6 NKJ)
- \* For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. (Gal 3:26 KJV)
- \* .... saints, and of the household of God; (Eph 2:19 KJV)
- \* ... built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone; (Eph 2:20 KJV)
- \* In whom all the building fitly framed together groweth unto an holy temple in the Lord: (Eph 2:21 KJV)
- \* In whom ye also are builded together for an habitation of God through the Spirit. (Eph 2:22 KJV)
- \* ... know ye ... that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost ....,.... (1Co 6:19 KJV)
- \* Know .... that Jesus Christ is in you (2Co 13:5 KJV) \* ... the hope of glory: (Col 1:27 KJV)
- \*... you are the body of Christ and individually members of it. (1Co 12:27 RSV)
- \* And he is the head of the body, the church (Col 1:18 KJV)
- \* ... God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, ... (Psa 89:7 KJV)
- \* ... the heathen shall know that I the LORD do sanctify Israel, when my sanctuary shall be in the midst of them for evermore. (Eze 37:28 KJV)
- \* Praise ye the LORD. I will praise the LORD with *my* whole heart, in the assembly of the upright, and *in* the congregation. (Psa 111:1 KJV)
- \*... he will ever be mindful of his covenant. (Psa 111:5 KJV)
- \* My God, my God .... (Psa 22:1 KJV)
- \* O my God, .... (Psa 22:2 KJV)
- \* ... thou art holy, O thou that inhabitest the praises of Israel. (Psa 22:3 KJV)
