In regards to: Atonement, what it means and why it is so essential to our faith and longevity in it! The essence of this study is to bring clarity to what it actually and literally means to be reconciled back to God through Christ (our Atonement).

Let's Build!

Reconciliation is that act of bringing things (or someone) back to a *normal* state of good relations, after hostility.

To be **Reconciled** means to be joined back together after harsh separation, by addressing the problems and establishing peace through forgiveness — restoring the friendship *andlor* relationship.

An **Atonement** is that which is given to compensate (or to make-up) for error or sin.

In regards to ransom, an atonement is given (or paid) to free a hostage or captive (one who is bound or enslaved, taken and held (and not released), until the ransom is paid)

Special Note: this made me think about when people get locked up (in prison/jail) for wrong doing (for breaking the law), and a loved one or friend comes to post their bail to have them released.

Further building on that point:

The person who puts the money up to free their friend or relative from jail/bondage, brings an atonement for that persons wrong doing, to restore their freedom.

The payment that is made to restore freedom -- is the atonement.

The person who comes to pay the ransom—atones for the wrong doer.

Remember, the price they pay to free the wrong doer, is the atonement.

The person who does this act to free another, takes on the wrong doers burden, by paying the cost for their wrongful acts—at their very own *personal* expense.

The person who does such is the propitiator who deals directly with the jail house and/or court, to satisfy the requirements needed, to free THE WRONG DOER—whom they Hold Legally BOUND for breaking the LAW!!



I tell you brothers and sisters, bound by your sins & iniquities;

That the Messiah Christ done these very acts for us, to Free and Deliver us from our sins, by paying the price for them—which is DEATH! Dying in our place, bearing the burdens of our iniquities in His body, that we may Live—Him in us and we in Him, partaking in His righteousness imputed unto us by faith in His blood shed atonement, for our sins! He completely paid the cost for them, redeeming us out of the hands of the devil who had taken us captive by ransom through our transgressions of the Law—by which we were separated from God and now have been Reconciled to Him through the New Covenant—by faith that is in His Son (Dir) Christ the Righteousness, Our Lord Saviour King & Redeemer the Propitiator, and Propitiation of our sins!

- * For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; (2Co 5:21 KJV)
- * ... God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. (Rom 5:8 KJV)
- * ... was buried, and rose again the third day (1Co 15:4 KJV)
- * Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father: (Gal 1:4 KJV)
- * ... being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him. (Rom 5:9 KJV)
- * ... joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement. (Rom 5:11 KJV)
- * Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: (Gal 3:13 KJV)
- * Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage. (Gal 5:1 KJV)
