- * ... they were all amazed, insomuch that they questioned among themselves, saying, What thing is this? what new doctrine *is* this? for with authority commandeth he even the unclean spirits, and they do obey him. (Mar 1:27 KJV)
- * And Jesus said, ... (Mat 15:16 KJV)
- * Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. (Joh 14:12 KJV)
- * And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: ... tarry ..., until ye be endued with power from on high. (Luk 24:49 KJV)
- * I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. (Mat 16:19 KJV)
- * And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him. (Col 3:17 KJV)
- * For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them. (Mat 18:20 KJV)

- * ... restore the pledge, give again that ... robbed, ... (Eze 33:15 KJV)
- * The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. (Joh 10:10 KJV)
- * O give thanks to the Lord of lords: for his mercy endureth for ever. (Psa 136:3 KJV)
- * ... as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, *even* to them that believe on his name: (Joh 1:12 KJV)
