- * ... at the same time they also learn *to be* idle, ... (1Ti 5:13 NAS)
- * ... and not only idle but also gossips and busybodies, saying things which they ought not. (1Ti 5:13 NKJ)
- * These are murmurers, complainers, walking after their own lusts; and their mouth speaketh great swelling words, (Jud 1:16 KJV)
- ...flattering people to gain advantage (Jud 1:16 NKJ)
- * ... these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith (2Ti 3:8 KJV)
- * but they will not get very far, (2Ti 3:9 RSV)
- * for their folly will be manifest to all (2Ti 3:9 NKJ)
- * ... as it is written, This people honoureth me with *their* lips, but their heart is far from me. (Mar 7:6 KJV)
- * Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience. (Eph 5:6 KJV)

- * For jealousy is the rage of a man: therefore he will not spare in the day of vengeance. (Pro 6:34 KJV)
- * To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts. (Heb 4:7 KJV)
