

Precept Study: The *Heart* of Giving!

In Regards to, putting yourself in a position to be able to give to those who need. There has been a significant increase in the amount of people afflicted in today's society. This is partly due to drastic inflation, oppression, persecution, war and also "advancements" in artificial intelligence – which results in mass job loss.

Another factor to consider in this equation is **sin**. In today's society more people than ever are forsaking the faith of Christ and cleaving to false religions, provoking God's wrath. True servants of God know that we as a people often shut out God's voice until time of affliction and hardship. This is usually one of the best times to minister to those in need, whether they realize it or not.

Our approach during this time must be precise in the spirit of love and meekness, in the fear of the Lord, understanding that He is God and Judge of all. In regards to ministering, I define this simply as providing that which you are capable of, to assist another in an area of need"

Ministers are givers! Providers! Helpers! Assistants! Servants! Don't allow this failing society to strip you of your God-given purpose! One of the hardest things to give or share in this current economic environment is money. As affliction increases and the economy worsens, people get even more greedy, selfish and insensitive to the needs of others.

As it is written;

* I have shewed you all things, how that so labouring ye ought to support the weak, and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, It is more blessed to give than to receive. (Act 20:35 KJV)

* But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully. (2Co 9:6 KJV)

- * Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver. (2Co 9:7 KJV)
- * And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work. (2Co 9:8 KJV)
- * But whoso hath this world's good, and seeth his brother have need, and shutteth up his bowels *of compassion* from him, how dwelleth the love of God in him? (1Jo 3:17 KJV)
- * Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: ... (Rom 13:10 KJV)
- * ... give to the poor; ... (Luk 19:8 KJV)
- * ... and needy: rid *them* out of the hand of the wicked. (Psa 82:4 KJV)
- * ... restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted. (Gal 6:1 KJV)
- * Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering; (Col 3:12 KJV)
- * Sell that ye have, and give alms; provide yourselves bags which wax not old, a treasure in the heavens that faileth not, where no thief approacheth, neither moth corrupteth. (Luk 12:33 KJV)
- * A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: ... (Mat 12:35 KJV)
- * ... let him labour, working with *his* hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth. (Eph 4:28 KJV)
- * ... walk honestly toward them that are without, ... *that* ye may have lack of nothing. (1Th 4:12 KJV)

* Turn not away thine eye from the needy, and give him none occasion to curse thee: (Sir 4:5 KJA)

* For if he curse thee in the bitterness of his soul, his prayer shall be heard of him that made him. (Sir 4:6 KJA)

* Get thyself the love of the congregation, and bow thy head to a great man. (Sir 4:7 KJA)

* Shut up alms in thy storehouses: and it shall deliver thee from all affliction. (Sir 29:12 KJA)
