

Precept Study: Division, Division – Who & What Should We Follow?

In Regards to, the fact that not every professing believer, or spiritual leader is to be followed. We are to follow after righteous examples, those truly serving Christ, who bring truth in humility, peaceably. Those who have genuine love for one another, who hold true to the scriptures - wholesome words! Those who really live their lives in subjection to the Messiah Christ.

Beware: If your leader [pastor or elder] is not following Christ as the scripture hath said. **Do Not Follow Them!** If you realize you have been deceived by false leaders, **Repent & Confess** yielding to and following after lies, the traditions of men which turned you from the Truth. Be thankful for the Grace of the Most High that you are alive and breathing and have the opportunity to get it Right. **Amen!**

Let the scriptures lay out for you who to follow, and who not to follow. Ultimately we all should be following Christ and yielding to the Truth. If we haven't already, we should also be Baptized and receive the Gift of the Holy Spirit. We should embrace it and be led by it! **All Praises, HONOR & GLORY be to the Most High GOD!**

As Apostle Paul stated - **Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ.** (1Co 11:1 KJV)

There is God ordained leadership in the earth, graced to shepherd the Lord's flock. You must judge the tree by the fruit! Beware as there are many different church denominations, "camps" etc... claiming they believe the scriptures. They claim they believe in the one true Christ, but remain DiViDED – through differences of doctrine, various beliefs, customs and traditions etc... This results in many of their followers being stuck in the middle, confused, and ultimately becoming pawns of the division as well, striving with fellow believers. **May those with eyes to see, see and ears to hear, hear!**

As it is written;

- * ... How can Satan cast out Satan? (Mar 3:23 KJV)
- * ... if a kingdom be divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. (Mar 3:24 KJV)
- * There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; (Eph 4:4 KJV)
- * One Lord, one faith, one baptism, (Eph 4:5 KJV)
- * One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all. (Eph 4:6 KJV)
- * Is Christ divided? was Paul crucified for you? or were ye baptized in the name of Paul? (1Co 1:13 KJV)

- * For while one saith, I am of Paul; and another, I am of Apollos; are ye not carnal? (1Co 3:4 KJV)
- * Who then is Paul, and who is Apollos, but ministers by whom ye believed, even as the Lord gave to every man? (1Co 3:5 KJV)

- * I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase. (1Co 3:6 KJV)
- * So then neither is he that planteth any thing, neither he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase. (1Co 3:7 KJV)

- * For ye are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men? (1Co 3:3 KJV)

- * This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish. (Jam 3:15 KJV)
- * But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. (Jam 3:17 KJV)

- * But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness; (1Co 1:23 KJV)
- * For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God. (1Co 1:18 KJV)

- * For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect. (1Co 1:17 KJV)

- * And I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the testimony of God. (1Co 2:1 KJV)
- * For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified. (1Co 2:2 KJV)

- * And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power: (1Co 2:4 KJV)
- * That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God. (1Co 2:5 KJV)

- * ... do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ. (Gal 1:10 KJV)

Many Christians and Hebrew Israelites profess to know God and say that they are following Christ. It's your responsibility to vet who you are listening to and following. Many professing believers are yielding to precepts and traditions of men that are contrary to the Knowledge and Instruction of the Most High God. You will be held individually accountable for this on the day of judgment along with those who are deceiving God's people. **We separate ourselves from the blind!**
