In regards to: 2nd Corinthians Chapter 3-5. Much was conveyed when reading these chapters. Here I share my highlights which are presented to you as a precept study! It is surely the Word of God that enlightens us. We are all dead to self, but indeed alive in Christ! **Embrace the Light!**

As it is written;

- ¹⁾ Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not;
- ²⁾ But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.
- ³⁾ But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: ⁴⁾ In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.
- ⁵⁾ For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake.
- ⁶⁾ For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.
- ⁷⁾ But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us. (2Co 4:1-7 KJV)
- ⁴⁾ And such trust have we through Christ to God-ward: ⁵⁾ Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency is of God; ⁶⁾ Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life. (2Co 3:4-6 KJV)
- * Wherefore we labour, that, whether present or absent, we may be accepted of him. (2Co 5:9 KJV)
- ¹⁵⁾ For all things are for your sakes, that the abundant grace might through the thanksgiving of many redound to the glory of God. ¹⁶⁾ For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day. (2Co 4:15-16 KJV)
- ¹⁰⁾ Always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our body. ¹¹⁾ For we which live are always delivered unto death for Jesus' sake, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our mortal flesh. ¹²⁾ So then death worketh in us, but life in you. (2Co 4:10-12 KJV)
- ¹⁴⁾ For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead: ¹⁵⁾ And that he died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again. (2Co 5:14-15 KJV)
- ²⁰⁾ Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God. ²¹⁾ For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. (2Co 5:20-21 KJV)
