In regards to: Many **professing believers** today (especially those in the "knowledge" of the truth) somehow have justified themselves in **using profanity**. Many are even using **curse words** in music made and directed toward believers. It is a stumbling stock and iniquity and by the Word of Almighty God, you should **STOP** and **#REPENT!** There is a snare set for those doing so, **this is a warning!**

As it is written;

* Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be. (Jam 3:10 KJV)

* let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints; (Eph 5:3 KJV)

* There is a word that is clothed about with death: God grant that it be not found in the heritage of Jacob; for all such things shall be far from the godly, and they shall not wallow in their sins. (Sir 23:12 KJA)

* Use not thy mouth to intemperate swearing, for therein is the word of sin. (Sir 23:13 KJA)

* Remember thy father and thy mother, when thou sittest among great men. Be not forgetful before them, and so thou by thy custom become a fool, and wish that thou hadst not been born, and curse the day of thy nativity. (Sir 23:14 KJA)

* The man that is accustomed to opprobrious words will never be reformed all the days of his life. (Sir 23:15 KJA)

* But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. (Mat 12:36 KJV)

* For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned. (Mat 12:37 KJV)

* But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine: (Tit 2:1 KJV)

* That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world; (Phi 2:15 KJV)

* Unto the pure all things are pure: but unto them that are defiled and unbelieving is nothing pure; but even their mind and conscience is defiled. (Tit 1:15 KJV)

* A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh. (Luk 6:45 KJV)
