

Precept Study: God Accepted Gentiles & Strangers Under the Old Covenant Too!

In Regards to: Negating false beliefs and ideologies that perpetuate that gentiles (or strangers) cannot be saved. Many camps or denominations amongst the **Hebrew Israelites** falsely believe that certain nationalities of people cannot receive Salvation. God's word begs to differ and **God's word is supreme!** These precepts are those referenced when dialoguing with a professing Hebrew Israelite, which centered the focus of our conversation on who won't and cannot be saved. I negated these falsehoods with scripture (more so old testament scriptures as he often resorted to them), and I directed the focus towards how we are truly saved – by faith through grace. Upon this discourse, I realized his religious group did not even believe that water baptism was required for Salvation. I ended the dialogue as it is no need to go back and forth about who can be saved, if one has not done the first works of Salvation themselves (believing in the Son, obeying the Gospel, Repenting of former sins and being Baptized as commanded). Here I share the precepts mentioned and shared with him in regards to God's heart towards the gentiles that turned to Him (under the Old Covenant). I pray these bible verses continue to serve the purpose intended!

As it is written;

- * ... there is no respect of persons with God. (Rom 2:11 KJV)
- * Tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile; (Rom 2:9 KJV)
- * (For not the hearers of the law [are] just before God, but the doers of the law shall be justified. (Rom 2:13 KJV)

- * ... if a stranger sojourn with thee in your land, ye shall not vex him. (Lev 19:33 KJV)
- * [But] the stranger that dwelleth with you shall be unto you as one born among you, and thou shalt love him as thyself; for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt: I [am] the LORD your God. (Lev 19:34 KJV)
- * Ye shall do no unrighteousness in judgment, in meteyard, in weight, or in measure. (Lev 19:35 KJV)
- * Just balances, just weights, a just ephah, and a just hin, shall ye have: I [am] the LORD your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt. (Lev 19:36 KJV)

- * Thus saith the LORD, Keep ye judgment, and do justice: for my salvation [is] near to come, and my righteousness to be revealed. (Isa 56:1 KJV)
- * Blessed [is] the man [that] doeth this, and the son of man [that] layeth hold on it; that keepeth the sabbath from polluting it, and keepeth his hand from doing any evil. (Isa 56:2 KJV)

- * Neither let the son of the stranger, that hath joined himself to the LORD, speak, saying, The LORD hath utterly separated me from his people: neither let the eunuch say, Behold, I [am] a dry tree. (Isa 56:3 KJV)
- * For thus saith the LORD unto the eunuchs that keep my sabbaths, and choose [the things] that please me, and take hold of my covenant; (Isa 56:4 KJV)
- * Even unto them will I give in mine house and within my walls a place and a name better than of sons and of daughters: I will give them an everlasting name, that shall not be cut off. (Isa 56:5 KJV)
- * Also the sons of the stranger, that join themselves to the LORD, to serve him, and to love the name of the LORD, to be his servants, every one that keepeth the sabbath from polluting it, and taketh hold of my covenant; (Isa 56:6 KJV)
- * Even them will I bring to my holy mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer: their burnt offerings and their sacrifices [shall be] accepted upon mine altar; for mine house shall be called an house of prayer for all people. (Isa 56:7 KJV)
- * The Lord GOD which gathereth the outcasts of Israel saith, Yet will I gather [others] to him, beside those that are gathered unto him. (Isa 56:8 KJV)
- * Only the LORD had a delight in thy fathers to love them, and he chose their seed after them, [even] you above all people, as [it is] this day. (Deu 10:15 KJV)
- * Circumcise therefore the foreskin of your heart, and be no more stiffnecked. (Deu 10:16 KJV)
- * For the LORD your God [is] God of gods, and Lord of lords, a great God, a mighty, and a terrible, which regardeth not persons, nor taketh reward: (Deu 10:17 KJV)
- * He doth execute the judgment of the fatherless and widow, and loveth the stranger, in giving him food and raiment. (Deu 10:18 KJV)
- * Love ye therefore the stranger: for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt. (Deu 10:19 KJV)
- * Thou shalt fear the LORD thy God; him shalt thou serve, and to him shalt thou cleave, and swear by his name. (Deu 10:20 KJV)
- * ... yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, (Rom 3:4 KJV)
- * ... Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons: (Act 10:34 KJV)
- * Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. (Col 2:8 KJV)
- * ... work out your own salvation with fear and trembling. (Phil 2:12 KJV)
