

# Precept Study: Letter to the Gentiles *Part-1*

*In Regards to:* a Reminder to my Gentile brothers and sisters in the faith of Christ in regards to conduct, staying clear of idolatry and contributing (sowing) back into God's people. **Part-1**

As it is written;

\* ..., behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, [thou] Son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil. (Mat 15:22 KJV)

\* But he answered and said, I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel. (Mat 15:24 KJV)

\* ..... and said, It is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast [it] to dogs. (Mat 15:26 KJV)

\* And she said, Truth, Lord: yet the dogs eat of the crumbs which fall from their masters' table. (Mat 15:27 KJV)

\* Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great [is] thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour. (Mat 15:28 KJV)

\* [Is he] the God of the Jews only? [is he] not also of the Gentiles? Yes, of the Gentiles also: (Rom 3:29 KJV)

\* For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. (Rom 1:16 KJV)

\* ... that the Gentiles might glorify God for [his] mercy; as it is written, For this cause I will confess to thee among the Gentiles, and sing unto thy name. (Rom 15:9 KJV)

\* Then pleased it the apostles and elders, with the whole church, to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; [namely], Judas surnamed Barsabas, and Silas, chief men among the brethren: (Act 15:22 KJV)

\* And they wrote [letters] by them after this manner; The apostles and elders and brethren [send] greeting unto the brethren which are of the Gentiles in Antioch and Syria and Cilicia: (Act 15:23 KJV)

\* I charge you by the Lord that this epistle be read unto all the holy brethren. (1Th 5:27 KJV)

\* .... we beseech you, brethren, to know them which labour among you, and are over you in the Lord, and admonish you; (1Th 5:12 KJV)

\* And to esteem them very highly in love for their work's sake. [And] be at peace among yourselves. (1Th 5:13 KJV)

# Precept Study: Letter to the Gentiles *Part-1*

- \* For yourselves know how ye ought to follow us: for we behaved not ourselves disorderly among you; (2Th 3:7 KJV)
  
- \* Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort [you] by the Lord Jesus, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to please God, [so] ye would abound more and more. (1Th 4:1 KJV)
  
- \* For ye know what commandments we gave you by the Lord Jesus. (1Th 4:2 KJV)
  
- \* For this is the will of God, [even] your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication: (1Th 4:3 KJV)
- \* That ye abstain from meats offered to idols, and from blood, and from things strangled, ..... (Act 15:29 KJV)
  
- \* That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour; (1Th 4:4 KJV)
- \* Not in the lust of concupiscence, even as the Gentiles which know not God: (1Th 4:5 KJV)
  
- \* That no [man] go beyond and defraud his brother in [any] matter: because that the Lord [is] the avenger of all such, as we also have forewarned you and testified. (1Th 4:6 KJV)
  
- \* Little children, keep yourselves from idols. .... (1Jo 5:21 KJV)
  
- \* For God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto holiness. (1Th 4:7 KJV)
  
- \* He therefore that despiseth, despiseth not man, but God, who hath also given unto us his holy Spirit. (1Th 4:8 KJV)
  
- \* But as touching brotherly love ye need not that I write unto you: for ye yourselves are taught of God to love one another. (1Th 4:9 KJV)
- \* And indeed ye do it toward all the brethren which are in all Macedonia: but we beseech you, brethren, that ye increase more and more; (1Th 4:10 KJV)
  
- \* For it hath pleased them of Macedonia and Achaia to make a certain contribution for the poor saints which are at Jerusalem. (Rom 15:26 KJV)
- \* It hath pleased them verily; and their debtors they are. For if the Gentiles have been made partakers of their spiritual things, their duty is also to minister unto them in carnal things. (Rom 15:27 KJV)
  
- \* For ye, brethren, became followers of the churches of God which in Judaea are in Christ Jesus: for ye also have suffered like things of your own countrymen, even as they [have] of the Jews: (1Th 2:14 KJV)
- \* Who both killed the Lord Jesus, and their own prophets, and have persecuted us; and they please not God, and are contrary to all men: (1Th 2:15 KJV)
  
- \* Forbidding us to speak to the Gentiles that they might be saved, to fill up their sins alway: for the wrath is come upon them to the uttermost. (1Th 2:16 KJV)
  
- \* As concerning the gospel, [they are] enemies for your sakes: but as touching the election, [they are] beloved for the fathers' sakes. (Rom 11:28 KJV)

# Precept Study: Letter to the Gentiles *Part-1*

- \* For the gifts and calling of God [are] without repentance. (Rom 11:29 KJV)
- \* But glory, honour, and peace, to every man that worketh good, to the Jew first, and also to the Gentile: (Rom 2:10 KJV)
- \* For as ye in times past have not believed God, yet have now obtained mercy through their unbelief: (Rom 11:30 KJV)
- \* For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in. (Rom 11:25 KJV)
- \* ..... that through your mercy they also may obtain mercy. (Rom 11:31 KJV)
- \* And so all Israel shall be saved: ..... (Rom 11:26 KJV)
- \* For God hath concluded them all in unbelief, that he might have mercy upon all. (Rom 11:32 KJV)
- \* Well; because of unbelief they were broken off, and thou standest by faith. Be not highminded, but fear: (Rom 11:20 KJV)\* \*
- \* Boast not against the branches. But if thou boast, thou bearest not the root, but the root thee. (Rom 11:18 KJV)
- \* For if God spared not the natural branches, [take heed] lest he also spare not thee. (Rom 11:21 KJV)
- \* ... indignation and wrath, (Rom 2:8 KJV)
- \* Tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile; (Rom 2:9 KJV)
