In Regards to, the fact that many professing believers in Christ are steadily compromising the faith, denying the Lord by fulfilling their own lustful desires. Whether it's through a respect of persons, refusal to reprove and correct one other, or just the fact that many have not truly been converted – compromise has entered into the church at an alarming rate! What standard are we living by? Is God's word negated because of your feelings or opinions? Is God's word subject to the influences of this wicked world? Will you continue to bow your knee to Baal? Will you continue to serve two masters? Will you remain a luke-warm Christian, swearing falsely by God's name? Will you repent and truly change or burn for eternity for abusing grace – justifying your detestable acts? God's word won't change, nor bend or fold to your carnal desires like most pastors and modern "translations".

As it is written;

- * For what *is* the hope of the hypocrite, though he hath gained, when God taketh away his soul? (Job 27:8 KJV)
- * O son of man, ... thou shalt hear the word at my mouth, and warn them from me. (Eze 33:7 KJV)
- * ... speak unto them, saying ... (Exo 16:12 KJV)
- * ... know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God. (Jam 4:4 KJV)
- * For all that *is* in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. (1Jo 2:16 KJV)
- * As it is written, ... (Rom 3:10 KJV)
- * This people honoureth me with *their* lips, but their heart is far from me. (Mar 7:6 KJV)
- * ... we dare not make ourselves of the number, or compare ourselves with some that commend themselves: but they measuring themselves by themselves, and comparing themselves among themselves, are not wise. (2Co 10:12 KJV)
- * They profess that they know God; but in works they deny *him*, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate. (Tit 1:16 KJV)

- * ... even their mind and conscience is defiled. (Tit 1:15 KJV)
- * And though they say, The LORD liveth; surely they swear falsely. (Jer 5:2 KJV)
- * Will ye steal, murder, and commit adultery, ... and burn incense unto Baal, and walk after other gods whom ye know not; (Jer 7:9 KJV)
- * And come and stand before me in this house, which is called by my name, and say, We are delivered to do all these abominations? (Jer 7:10 KJV)
- * Woe unto the wicked! *it shall be ill with him*: for the reward of his hands shall be given him. (Isa 3:11 KJV)
- * ... for all these *are things* that I hate, saith the LORD. (Zec 8:17 KJV)
- * Why tempt ye me, *ye* hypocrites? (Mat 22:18 KJV)

- * I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot. (Rev 3:15 KJV)
- * So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth. (Rev 3:16 KJV)
- * ... thou thoughtest that I was altogether *such an one* as thyself: *but* I will reprove thee, and set *them* in order before thine eyes. (Psa 50:21 KJV)

- * ... in the latter days ye shall consider it. (Jer 30:24 KJV)
- * For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God. (Eph 5:5 KJV)
- * No man can serve two masters: (Mat 6:24 KJV)
- * Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils. (1Co 10:21 KJV)

- * He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day. (Joh 12:48 KJV)

- * And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity. (Mat 7:23 KJV)
- * And .. there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. (Mat 24:51 KJV)
- * Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out ... (Act 3:19 KJV)
